

## **Making sight words fun – activities**

**Learning and practice can be lots of fun.**

**Try one of these fun activities this week and let me know how it went.**

**Flashlight Words** – Turn off the lights (this must be done after dark)

Tape words on the wall or ceiling. Use a flashlight to shine on the word, then have your child read the word. See how many they get correct.

**Go Fish** – Use a duplicate set of word cards to play “Go Fish”

You can easily make your own cards out of index cards.

**Stepping Stones** – Place the word cards on the floor, making a fun stream going across the room.

Have your child walk over the stream. As they step on the stepping stone (word), have them say the word before they move on to get to the other side of the stream.

**Word Hunt** – Look for target words in books or in the newspaper. If using the newspaper your child can highlight or circle the words he/she finds.

**Concentration** – Create 2 sets of word cards. Place the word cards face down. Have your child turn over 2 cards, trying to make a match. Continue until all of the words are matched.

**Beat the Clock** – See how many times your child can write a word in 1 minute. Or you could see how many flash cards your child can name in 1 minute.

**Salt Tray** – Grab a tray or baking sheet with edges. Pour in salt. Write the word in the salt. When your child says the word correctly, they get to erase the word.
